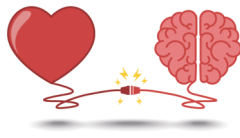

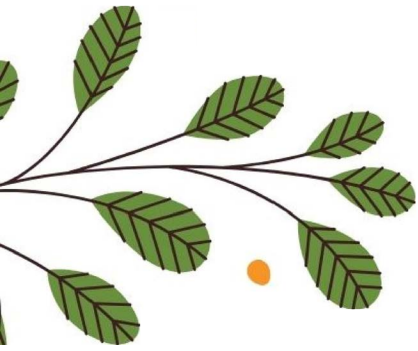

3 Ways to Register:

Picking up and Completing Registration Forms at the School: Please see our Administrative Assistant at our front office to get the registration form. If needed, please ask for any assistance with the form

Dropping off Registration Package: Drop off the forms at any time. Please complete them Online then print them off or pick up from the school.

Emailing: Please email the registration form using the email provided above. Registration forms are available on the school and divisional websites as fillable forms. Please fill them in, save them, and attach them to an email to send them in.

What you will need:

- Child's birth certificate (provide a copy, or you can request a photocopy from the school)
- Proof of Address (Legal Land Description with Legal Guardian's Name); i.e. Driver's License, Utility Bill, Lease Agreement, etc.
- MB Health Card listing the Parent and Child's Name
