Tri-Conferences will occur April 10 from 4:00 to 7:00 and April 11 from 9:00 to noon.

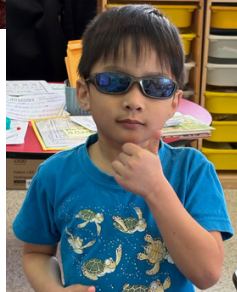
Please drop by to talk with teachers during this time to reflect with your child on their achievements and discuss areas for growth.

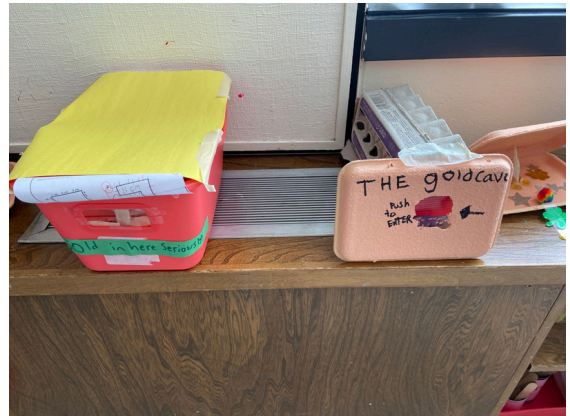
